DESCRIPTION

'Arches of Porto Venere' captures the timeless elegance and architectural beauty of the Ligurian coast. This abstract watercolor evokes the charm of Porto Venere, where ancient arches frame breathtaking seascapes, blending history with nature's fluidity.

The interplay of earthy greens, azure blues, and soft grays mirrors the weathered stone structures meeting the vibrant Mediterranean waters. Bold lines and intersecting shapes suggest fragments of arches, windows, and pathways shaped by centuries of wind and waves, inviting the viewer to imagine wandering through these historic corridors.

Arnaud Quercy's layered brushstrokes and transparent washes create a sense of depth and motion, as if light and shadow dance across the surfaces of ancient walls.
