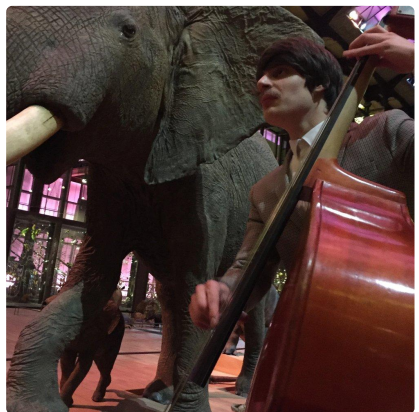
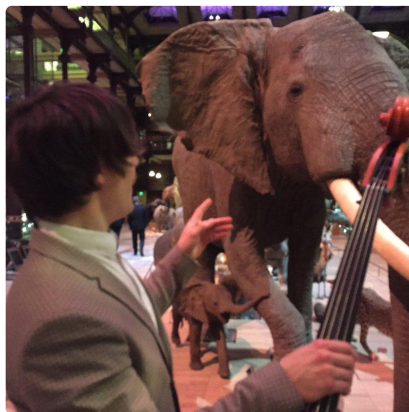
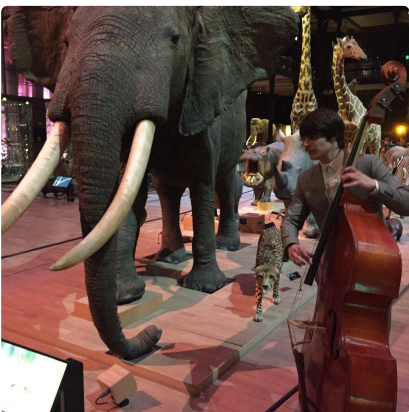
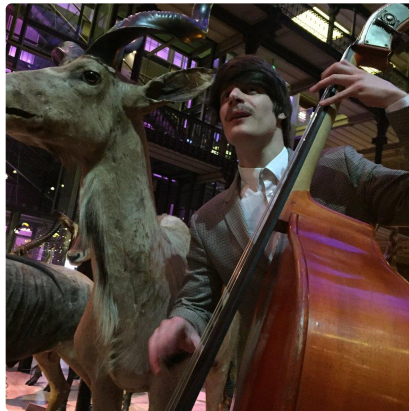
On 14 March 2019, Elements Jazz played a huge private party inside the Muséum national d'Histoire naturelle in Paris — a trio of piano, double bass and drums.

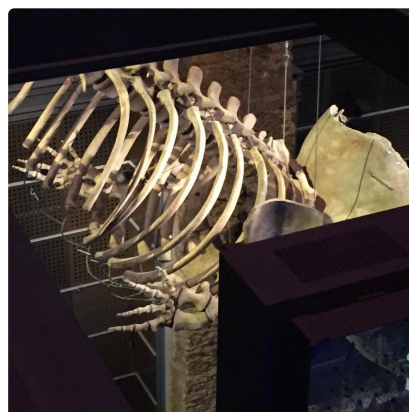
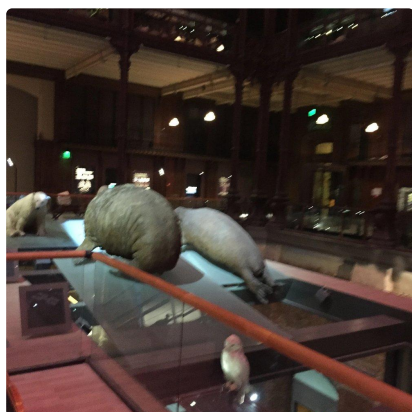
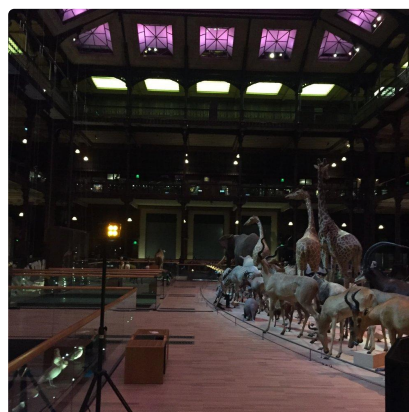
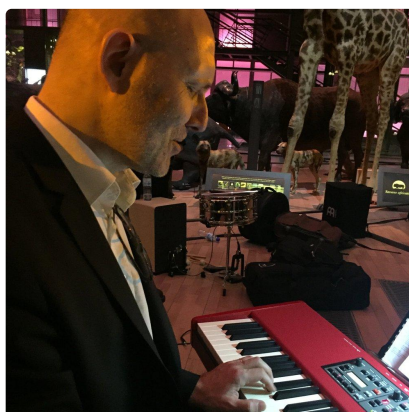
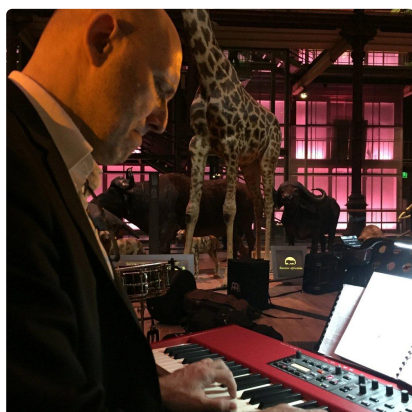
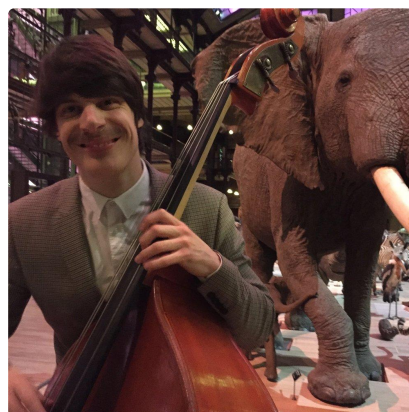
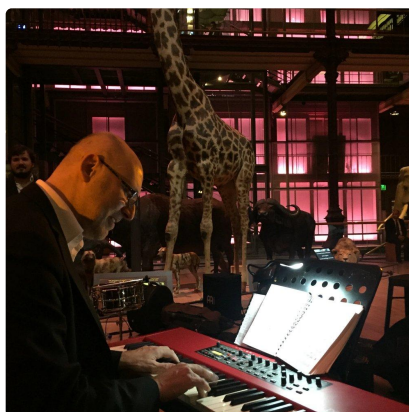
